- Read carefully and sign **Contract of Responsibility**
- Fill out **Enrollment Form** (please include those who are authorized to pick up your child)
- Sign and notarize the **Emergency Medical Release** (we have a notary on staff)
- Current **immunization record** with Doctor's stamp or signature.
- Provide a recent **Child Health Assessment** (physical)
- Fill out a **Medical Record Form**
- For students transferring from another school, a release of records form must be signed
- Provide a copy of child's **Birth Certificate**

Immunizations and physical can be faxed to the school from your doctor's office. **ECS FAX 342-8686**

Requirements:

- Students are considered enrolled after all forms are handed in and a fee of \$50.00 is paid.
- Pre-school students must be at least three years old and potty trained.
- Kindergarten students must be five years old on or before August 31.
- First grade students must be six years old on or before August 31, the year they begin 1st grade.
- Students will be admitted on a probationary period for the first semester.
- Student grades 1-8 applying after the first quarter must receive Board of Directors approval.

His ascension to the right hand of God (Mark 16:19),
His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11, Revelation 19:11).
